

# Personal Maps With a Twist

## Preparation

1. Send out instructions for people to create their maps
2. Leave it up to the participants to pick themes but some examples might be Home, Work, Family, Games, Pets, Education, Hobbies, Books, Goals or Values.
3. Connected to the themes the participants write facts about themselves
4. Leave the middle blank
5. Add 1 thing that is not true

## Running The Session

1. Fold up and put the maps in a big bowl or a pile in the middle of the table
2. Take turns pulling a map
3. Present the person the map is about
4. The group should try to guess who's map it is. Once they have figured it out you write the name in the middle.
5. The group now tries to figure out what fact on the map is a lie. Once it has been found you circle it with a bright color.

## After The Session

- Post the maps in the team area (or a shared folder if you are a remote team)
- Ask new team members to create their maps when they join the team
- Have someone present the map. Could be an onboarding buddy, their manager or another team member
- Post the new map with the other maps
